I love riding my bike, I ride my bike all over the place. Its good memories. One time I ran into a mailbox another time I ran into a van. All good memories."

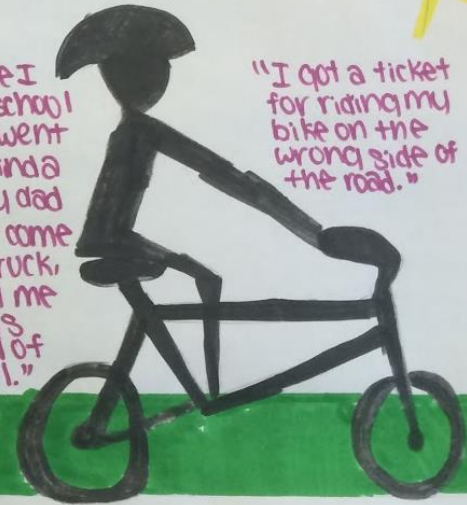

GOING TO SCHOOL



"When I was a kid growing up in Lebanon, to go to school, I had to take an a taxi bus to it. Not like the school buses you have here, but we had to get inside a public transport bus, a 'jeepney' I think, to the elementary school. It was pretty close, but not really close long. We had to get up early and it took about 15 minutes to get to school. I went to high school, it was a much longer bus ride because the school was further away. I remember one day because of money and I actually had to get out of the bus, so I had to get off one bus and then change to a different bus to get to school. Probably took a half an hour to get to school and to get back again."


"I don't remember a collection of bringing into anyone, particularly kids, but we would bring in some of our friends of course, family, our father and relatives. I didn't have any relatives. I didn't have any relatives. My grandpa lived in Lebanon and he was younger than me and we went to a different school so we didn't go going to work, and just because I must have seen people that we as I did."

"One of the things that I remember is that there was a fish and chip shop by one of the bus stops that I had to go on the way to school and I remember fish and chips. They had really small ones with the cooking oil and vinegar and pickles. I remember the smell of the used stove. And there was a candy store that had used to sell things like on the way from school used to like they were called 'bandos' and they were not like the hard ones, soft ones, so I always remember those. That was a lot of fun."



"I remember one time we walked to go school without any slippers because we were so poor. We'd used to go to school with ripped clothes, no slippers, bags we didn't care. We never cared what we wore or had. We only cared going to school for knowledge and education."

"One time on the way to school, we were walking on our barefoot then I slipped on a huge nail, I kept bleeding. And so my sister grabbed a bunch of grass to stop the bleeding."

Burmingham



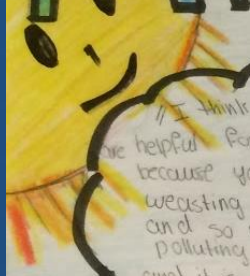

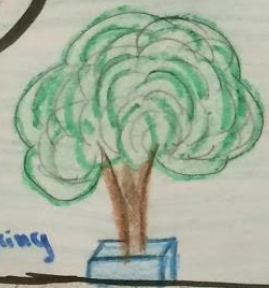

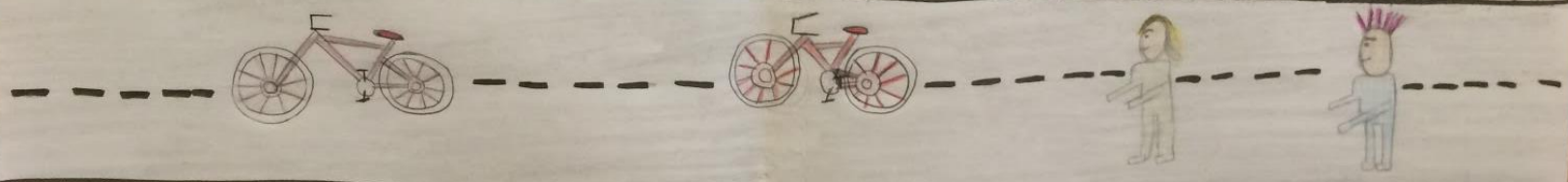
