
What is the ECF?

- Influence laws on a wide variety of subjects (look at our website for more information (WWW.ECF.COM)



Distant, but relevant





- Funding (100bn spent on transport in the last budget period)

- Regulated the rights of Passengers and pushes for mutli-modal transport planning




